With over 3,500 sq. miles of territory, PDRTA covers the most area in the state and is the **3<sup>rd</sup> largest territory** in the US.

Since August 2023, PDRTA and Ruiz Foods have joined forces to provide a tailored workforce transportation solution for work visa holders, creating a model for diversity and inclusion.

### Customized Transportation Routes

The heart of this collaboration lies in the development of a personalized workforce transportation route that caters specifically to the needs of visa holders working at Ruiz Foods.

The route is designed to take the work visa employees to and from work to their residence. PDRTA also provides these employees with a supplemental service in the event an emergency arises with the need to leave during their shift.

The door to door service provided by PDRTA to Ruiz Foods ensures that transportation barriers do not hinder their ability to contribute to the workplace.

# Next Stop: Chesterfield County

Beginning January 29<sup>th</sup>, we will have two new fixed routes in Chesterfield County. One route will connect McBee, Jefferson and Pageland. The other route will connect Cheraw, Chesterfield and Pageland going through Ruby and Mt Croghan. Each route will provide five round trips on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with Demand Response available on Tuesdays and Thursdays for Patrick and Cash.

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, we will begin the Pageland Express. This route will have 30+ stops in and around Pageland and will connect with the two connect routes from around the County.

This expansion is not just about routes; it's about connecting people and making everyday journeys more accessible. We look forward to being an integral part and enhancing the quality of life in Chesterfield, SC.
